1. Participation in the webinar is via ZOOM Webinar app. If you are logging in from a mobile phone then please download the app from your respective app store. For those logging in from a desktop you shall have to download the Zoom desktop client. Alternatively, you may install the Zoom add-on/extension for your browser if logging in through the browser.
2. All the participants will be provided with the link latest by one hour before the webinar start time.
3. Once you click on the link you will be automatically directed to the Zoom webinar waiting room. You will be asked to register with your meeting id, email, name and password. Once that is done you will be put on hold. Your host will admit you after accepting your request. **Please note that only the first 500 participants will be allowed into the room. Once the 500 count is reached Zoom will lock the room and your entry is possible only if a void is created by someone leaving the room.**
4. Kindly enter with audio and video muted. (Zoom webinar will admit you in muted form). Please do not attempt to unmute your audio.
5. You will be allowed to ask questions via Q&A button after the webinar during Q&A session.
6. Please do not use chat for asking questions.
